### **DEPARTMENT OF TRUST LANDS FIELD INSPECTORS IN YOUR AREA**

Local field inspectors inspect most school trust lands on a 5-year schedule. Because of the large amount of land that they must inspect each summer, they usually won't stop by or call before conducting an inspection. Weather permitting; they may drive in the pastures with vehicles identified by a sign in the window.
